Religious Accommodations Policy (State Mandated Policy) BOT Approved: August 15, 2023

PURPOSE:

In accordance with Maryland SB662/HB923, the College is required to adopt and provide to students a policy that provides reasonable academic accommodations to practice sincerely held faith-based or religious beliefs.

POLICY:

Students shall be provided a reasonable accommodation, including excused absences, for a student to observe faith-based or religious holidays or participate in organized faith-based or religious activities. Students shall be given an opportunity, whenever feasible, to make up within a reasonable time any academic assignment or examination that is missed due to individual participation in faith-based or religious observances.

Students should make any reasonable religious accommodation requests to the professor/instructor of a course. Students are asked to examine the course syllabus/schedule for potential conflicts at the start of a course and promptly notify the professor/instructor of any anticipated reasonable accommodation needs, providing as much notice as possible.

Faculty/instructors who need guidance or assistance regarding reasonable accommodations for faith-based or religious observances, or students who have questions or concerns regarding reasonable accommodations, may contact the Director of Institutional Compliance & Safety at equitycompliance@garrettcollege.edu.
